**Submission/Registration Deadline: Monday, March 27th, 2023**

### Who can participate?

All undergraduate and graduate students, from all CSU campuses and community colleges, doing research in any social science field. Individual and group papers are welcome.

### What is it?

An opportunity to present your research to your peers and compete for a cash award. Presentations will be approximately 12-15 minutes. There will be four \$500 awards for best undergraduate paper, best graduate paper, and best use of quantitative data, best use of qualitative data in a paper.

### How do I participate?

The submission/registration deadline is March 27th, 2023. If you want to compete for one of the paper awards you must submit a full paper (maximum 20 pages) with your submission. To present your research without competing for an award, you only need to submit an abstract (120-250 words).
